11TH GRADE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS-NCSS IMMUNIZATION LETTER

-All students enrolled or entering Newton County Schools **MUST** be up to date on all mandatory vaccines to attend school. Please be advised of the Georgia Department of Public Health requirement for students entering the 11th grade.

-NCSS students are invited to a vaccination clinic hosted by the Gwinnett, Newton, and Rockdale (GNR) Public Health <u>Thursday</u>, <u>August 24, 2023</u>, from 3:00 p.m.- 5:00 p.m.at <u>Porter Performing Arts Center</u>. This clinic will offer the Meningitis vaccine required for 11th grade students, and COVID-19 Booster vaccinations for those age 12 and older. Please bring an ID and insurance card if you have them available. A parent/guardian must accompany students under the age of 18. Please see below for a summary of information.

EHS ATHLETICS

-Students must be passing at least five courses at the end of the first semester to be eligible for activities during the second semester.

-Tickets must be redeemed at the gate of entry. Screenshot pictures of tickets are not valid and will not be honored.

-NCSS employees may use their school system identification badges and sign-in at the gate for free admission to any regular season home EHS non playoff event.

-As a measure of security, spectators will not be permitted to bring bookbags or large bags into athletic events. Small clutch bags, with or without a handle or strap, that do not exceed 4.5" X 6.5" are acceptable.

-Students under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a supervising adult. Any student under the age of 14 who is not with a supervising adult will not be permitted in the stadium.

-No outside food, drink, or coolers are allowed in the game venue (stadium, gym, field, etc.)

-No tobacco or vaping products.

-No weapons of any kind.

-All items are subject to search by game administrator

-Entry gates will close at halftime of events or once manageable capacity is reached and entry will not be permitted once gates are closed.

An accumulation of more than 10 unexcused absences will result in a loss of course credit.
