## 11TH GRADE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS-NCSS IMMUNIZATION LETTER

- -All students enrolled or entering Newton County Schools **MUST** be up to date on all mandatory vaccines to attend school. Please be advised of the Georgia Department of Public Health requirement for students entering the 11th grade.
- -Effective as of July 1, 2021, children 16 years of age and older, including those who are new entrants or transfers into a Georgia school in the 11th grade, will be required to show proof of a booster dose of the **meningococcal conjugate vaccine**, unless their first dose was received on or after their sixteenth birthday.

## STUDENT ATTENDANCE PRIORITY

- -Students should arrive at school in a safe manner prior to the 8:15 AM beginning of the school day. An accumulation of more than four tardies to school or class will result in Saturday Work Detail, ISS, and OSS.
- -If a student is absent from school, the student may submit up to five parent notes to the first period teacher to excuse an absence. Beyond five parent notes, documentation from a doctor or other formal entity will be required to excuse an absence. An accumulation of more than 10 unexcused absences will result in a loss of course credit.
