Acceptance as a Junior Volunteer is contingent upon satisfactory references and verification of the information submitted. You will be notified through e-mail as to whether or not you have been accepted to the program.

About the Program

The summer Junior Volunteer Program runs for 7 weeks from **June 4 to July 19, 2019**. The program is available to high school students from Newton County schools and children/grandchildren of employees and volunteers.

To participate you must be entering the 10th, 11th or 12th grade for the 2019 - 2020 school year and maintain at least a B average in all studies.

The Junior Volunteer Program is not an internship program; it is a service to Piedmont Newton Hospital. The program provides an opportunity for students to gain exposure to a hospital environment while making a contribution to the community by volunteering their time and talents to the hospital.

Who We Are

For more than 60 years, Piedmont Newton Hospital has served Newton County and surrounding communities with high-quality, patient-centered care.

On October 1, 2015, Piedmont Newton joined Piedmont Healthcare, expanding the health system's high quality of services and professionals to the residents of Newton County and surrounding areas.

Program Requirements

- Serve a minimum of 20 hours by volunteering one, four-hour shift per week.
- First time applicants: Interviews will be held between **3:30 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 19 and Thursday, March 21. We will also have interviews from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, March 23.** A parent/guardian is required to attend the interview as a mandatory part of the application process.
- **Returning Junior Volunteers** are required to interview and need to call the volunteer office during the week of March 4 to set up an interview appointment for the week of March 11. A parent/guardian is not required to attend the interviews of returning Jr. Volunteers.
- Purchase a \$20 Piedmont uniform polo shirt.
- Complete the tuberculosis test requirements. TB tests will be provided by Piedmont Newton Hospital at no charge. Parent or guardian must accompany student. Date will be announced.
- Attend the mandatory orientation on **Tuesday, June 4 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., or Thursday, June 6 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Details will be given closer to the date. You will need to register and attend only one of these classes.**
- Provide list of dates you will be unable to work this summer due to a family vacation, driver's education, band camp, sports, etc. by June 7, 2019. **20 hours of service must be completed to fulfill your commitment.**
